

2023-2032 Biomass Tax Credit

CERTIFICATE OF EFFICIENCY

Applicable systems, whether they are stoves purchased to heat space or larger, whole-home heating systems, once again qualify for a renewable energy investment tax credit (Section 25(C) of the Internal Revenue Code).

Beginning in 2023, consumers buying highly efficient wood or pellet stoves will be able to claim a 30% tax credit, capped at \$2000 annually. The credit is for appliances installed between January 1, 2023 and December 31, 2032.

To be eligible for this credit the appliance must have a thermal efficiency of at least 75% (HHV).
